**(3) APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

**a.** Regular Meeting Minutes of February 10, 2021

Commissioner Mould made a motion to approve the Regular Meeting Minutes of February 10, 2021. Commissioner Yancy seconded the motion.

**MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY**

**(4) REPORTS**

- a. Financial Report
  - b. Waste Management Report
- Reports were reviewed and presented to the commission by Ms Mould.

**(5) AWARDS**

- a. Recognition of Good Neighbor Awards for:
  - 1. Esther Bolton for her service to the community as city receptionist and for always looking out for the residents of Briar Meadow
  - 2. Sheryl Thornton Tillson for her love of La Marque, being a voice of standards & ethics, and her commitment to special needs children of the city
  - 3. Joseph Lowry for going above and beyond during the winter storm by providing free hot meals to the community for three straight days
  - 4. Lori Stokes Walsh for reaching out to LMPD to donate blankets to the homeless before the freeze came in.
  - 5. Cecilia Fields, Lakiesha Stinson, & Michael Phillips for performing over 90 welfare checks on the elderly citizens of the city, while a few were given to them in a list from the Fire Dept, most were well known by Code Compliance from periodic checks. Additionally, Officer Fields provided sweatshirts to one citizen who only had a blanket, and a blanket to another elderly citizen that lives alone.

Chairperson Brown reminded everyone that the conference will be online again this year and noted that the cost will be \$99/person for a total cost of \$594 for everyone to attend  
Vice Chair Herrin made a motion to approve the cost and Commissioner Pettijohn seconded the motion.

**(7) NEW BUSINESS**

- a. Discussion/possible action regarding approval of funds for KTB affiliate dues  
It was noted that the cost of dues were \$175 and had been paid.  
Commissioner Mould made a motion to approve the expenditure with Ms Herrin seconding.

**MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY**

- b. Discussion/possible action amending the KLMBC annual calendar by changing the date to May 1<sup>st</sup> for the internal start of Paint the Town Program  
Ms Mould made a motion to approve the change, with Commissioner Loftis seconding.

**MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY**

- c. Discussion/possible action to approve expenditures of up to \$1,000 for Spring Clean-up/Trash-off supplies and marketing
- d. Discussion/possible action amending the KLMBC annual calendar by adding the date for Shred Day as April 10, 2021 and to approve expenditures of up to \$1,000 for supplies and marketing

- e. Discussion/possible action to approve expenditures of up to \$2,000 for Beautify the Bayou supplies and marketing
- f. Discussion/possible action to authorize expenditures of up to \$500 for Earth Day participation

Ms Herrin will send information regarding what will be needed for a plant and where to buy the plants and equipment for Beautify the Bayou and Earth Day events.

Ms Herrin made a motion to accept items c – f and Commissioner Yancey seconded the motion.

**MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY**

- g. Discussion/possible action regarding development and adoption of parameters for Good Neighbor Awards

Ms Brown explained the need to set parameters/guidelines for makes a Good Neighbor nominations. Parameters proposed were that there must be a notable, visible action that can be tied to that person; the nominees be residents of La Marque, with the only exception being law enforcement officers from city and county; the nomination form must be filled out for each nominee.

Ms Herrin made a motion to approve the parameters with Ms Yancey seconding.

**MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY**

- h. Discussion/possible action regarding development and adoption of parameters for Yards of the month

Ms Brown explained how there had been no organized parameters set for the Yard of the Month and why there should be so that everyone was on the same page. Parameters proposed were: only La Marque addresses; no standing code violations against the address; nice landscaping or habitation in the yard; quirky/fun yard; no junk-vehicle or otherwise-that would go against Code; Prior contact with nominees so they know they're getting the sign put in their yard; the nomination form must be filled out for each nominee; the signs will be placed on the first of each month.

Ms Yancey made a motion to accept the parameters and Ms Herrin seconded the motion.

**MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY**

**(8) REQUESTS AND ANNOUNCEMENTS**

Mr Pettijohn stated that a food drive at Queen of Peace was coming up on Saturday and noted a need for volunteers. Mr Loftis voiced concern about areas around town being used as dumping sites. Ms Van Stavern asked that any sites noticed be placed in Request Tracker. Ms Yancey stated that Neighborhood Baptist Church was tentatively going to hold Covid-19 vaccinations on March 27 and that CVS was holding walk in vaccinations at their locations.

**(9) ADJOURNMENT**

Mr Pettijohn made a motion to adjourn the meeting and Ms Mould seconded the motion.

Residential, Commercial, Industrial and Recycling

As La Marque's preferred environmental services partner, Waste Management provides Waste and Recycling collection for Residential, Commercial and Industrial customers in the City of La Marque.

Waste Management provides curbside waste, recycling, bulk and green waste collection to **6,592** homes each week. Our various residential services performed by our collection team delivers **99,902** personal touches each month to the City of La Marque residents.

In addition to residential services, Waste Management provides waste collection to **420** Commercial Businesses each month, equaling **3,656** services per month.

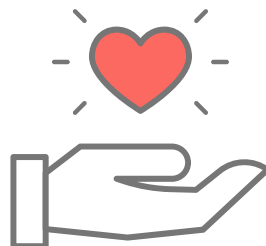
