 - 4.I. Parks and Natural Areas 2024 Awards Ceremony - ***ITEM TABLED 03.20.2025***
NO DISCUSSION.
 - 4.II. Public Works Update : Amanda Hobby
Assistant Public Works Director Hobby, stated that Hollywood Construction won the bid for the football field renovation and the City is working on establishing their account and purchase order.
Finance Director Turner updated the status of all park grant financials. The \$10,000 grant proceeds will have an account to track expenditures and will be under Fund 81. Ms. Turner also stated that the Parks Board has \$21,946 under Fund 81. Chairperson Bock questioned the amount and stated that the board had not spent \$9,000 throughout the current fiscal year. Ms. Turner reviewed her figures and shared that the board should have roughly \$27,000 in Fund 81.
Contracted Grant Writer Alice Ashley stated that we received \$10,000 from the Southwest Coca-Cola beverage company. This is an environmental grant to teach

the community about recycling. Amanda Hobby will be pricing commercial recycling cans, and need to place the Coca-Cola logo on the grant-funded cans. Chairperson Bock asked Ms Alice Ashley about the bike audit grant of \$2500.00; that money is still in their account, and they can spend it on striping, crosswalks, and signage. The Vice Chairperson asked about doing bike giveaways in this grant.

Vice Chairperson Griffin shared that a couple of years ago, the Parks Board participated in the "Parks for Pollinators Bio Blitz," and the program will send a kit when requested and create an account on their website which can link the account to La Marque Parks. This helps build a database with the community's involvement to identify different birds, butterflies, and plants by taking pictures. As a result of this database, the City will be eligible for prizes, recognitions, and bird and butterfly certifications. **NO ACTION TAKEN.**

Parks Board requested that a proposed draft for the Parks Board budget be created so that the board can make recommendations on what to spend this money on. They also request was made about the Solar Light project for Bayou Park. The Board also welcomed Robert Young to the board.

meeting. She also requested an item for the next meeting to discuss applications for no-match grants.

Board member Wev requested an update on Mahan Park football field.

We are N Zone Sports – Houston Bay Area. We are a **Fun-First**, No Try-out, Everyone Plays, Coed League that is a balanced blend of recreation and healthy competition. We pride ourselves on the implementation of our core values throughout all programs. Each week has a focus value of Teamwork, Sportsmanship, Effort, or Self-Control, and every week all coaches award a player (or two) with a Value Award recognizing a child of displaying that week's value. By the end of the season – every player will have received a value award. On top of this – we believe in rewarding the hard work and dedication that our player's show consistently throughout the season. Therefore – Every player will also receive an achievement award if they do not qualify for the championship trophy game. *Youngest divisions do not hold championships & all players receive trophies.

Our league makes team sports available to children ages 3 - 12 in the form of once-a-week leagues for a duration of an 8- or 10-week season. We acknowledge park access is for public use & will make sure the community still has free use of the facilities without conflict. We do not need regular use of the pavilion – and will not impede on any rentals of the pavilion. Our partnership will also show that the City of La Marque is making strides to have a positive impact on local youth by allowing us to provide our all-inclusive sports program to this area.

Our partnership has potential for major growth due to us having over 3,000+ families who are in our current database that already trust us & will trust when we show our efforts & initiatives to drive more traffic to Mac McGaffey Highland Bayou Park. We guarantee you will see the impact we will bring, while this partnership will give us the assurance that N Zone Sports – Houston Bay Area has a facility to call “HOME”.

We would like to start showing you our drawing power to the community by using the open field space every Saturday from June 21st through August 23rd by hosting an 8-week Soccer and Cheer Season for kids ages 3 – 12, this includes an added week in the event of a rain out. We are estimating 100 kids minimum to be registered in this league, and that is on the low end since we are already into April and have not yet begun marketing. To promote this initial league at a minimum adequacy – we would need approval by April 19th. Outside of that approval date – we may need to push the beginning and ending dates. I believe there was an event planned for July 5th already – we will schedule a bi-week for that Saturday, so that we do not create a scheduling issue.

We are aware that the park is closed for rentals the entire month of October. We would like to host an 8 week Fall Soccer, Cheer, and Flag Football season due to this closure – For the Saturday Dates November 1st – December 27th. (This includes a 9th Saturday for possible rain reschedules)

We would continue into a Spring 2026 promotion for Soccer, flag-football, & Cheer for the dates of March 21st – May 16th (This includes a 9th Saturday for possible rain reschedules)

TERMS

We would like to offer a partnership that would be beneficial. As stated in purpose, we are looking to grow together as a part of the community and provide a long-term home for our community's youth through N Zone Sports. We would like to agree to the following terms.

- We agree to a \$4 return on every child registered in the program to play at Highland Bayou Park. To be paid out within 14 days after the season's Opening Family Day and paid based on final registration count. Average enrollment is 200-300 kids per season when at least 2 sports are promoted.
- We will reserve the right to advertise at the hosting park without bothering families but to bring awareness.
- We will be an exclusive youth sports partner to the City of La Marque at the Mac McGaffey Highland Bayou Park facility and will not work with competitor leagues. (including but not limited to: i9 Sports, Skyhawks, Soccer Shots, HTX, FFPS)
- We will line all our own soccer fields, provide all equipment for practices and games, and will remove all equipment after all scheduled N Zone Sports Events. The only request is that the fields are mowed at a frequency that keeps the grass levels at an acceptable height for play, and that the park is sprayed for mosquitoes when necessary
- We would like to hold the ability to invite food and beverage vendors to the fields during league play. Given that the vendors obtain the proper permitting necessary to do so.
- We would like to hold the ability to invite league sponsors and local businesses as vendors to participate in the Opening Family Day Activities. (3 per year)
- We will help promote our partnership by adding the City of La Marque Emblem to our printed and online flyers, and on uniforms if requested.
- We will gladly partner with the city to bring sports fields, or any of our carnival style games to city or school district events if given a minimum 21- day notice of the date and items being requested.
- We will not impede on pavilion rentals and will make sure that our parents and participants respect those who have reserved the right to be there.
- We will do our due diligence in maintaining the facilities while in attendance and will leave the facilities in the same (or better) condition as initially presented.

We are happy to discuss any additional terms the City would like to present. We would also be interested in discussing use of the baseball field at Mac McGaffey if we are able to eventually get the field in good shape, or additional use of any indoor facilities available for basketball, volleyball, indoor soccer, and cheer programs in the future.

This agreement will be valid for a term of 2 years. From the dates of April 19th, 2025, to April 19th, 2027. The ability will remain to review terms of partnership during this time if both parties agree to new terms.
