Residential, Commercial, Industrial and Recycling

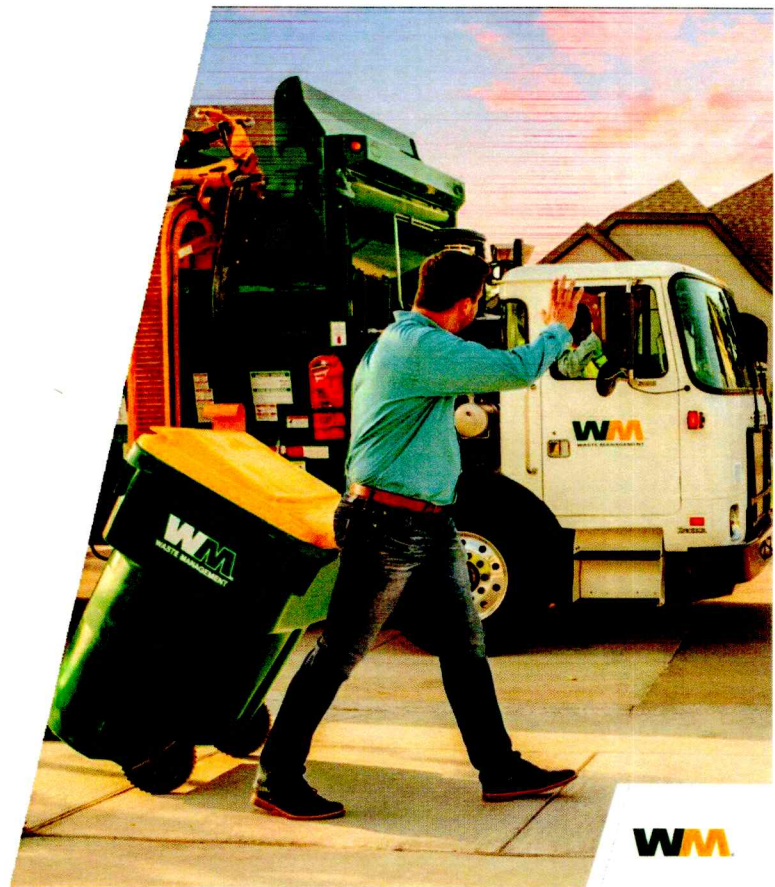
As La Marque's preferred environmental services partner, Waste Management provides Waste and Recycling collection for Residential, Commercial and Industrial customers in the City of La Marque.

Waste Management provides curbside waste, recycling, bulk and green waste collection to **7,317** homes each week. Our various residential services performed by our collection team delivers **118,243** personal touches each month to the City of La Marque residents.

In addition to residential services, Waste Management provides waste collection to **301** commercial Businesses each month, equaling **3,884** services per month.

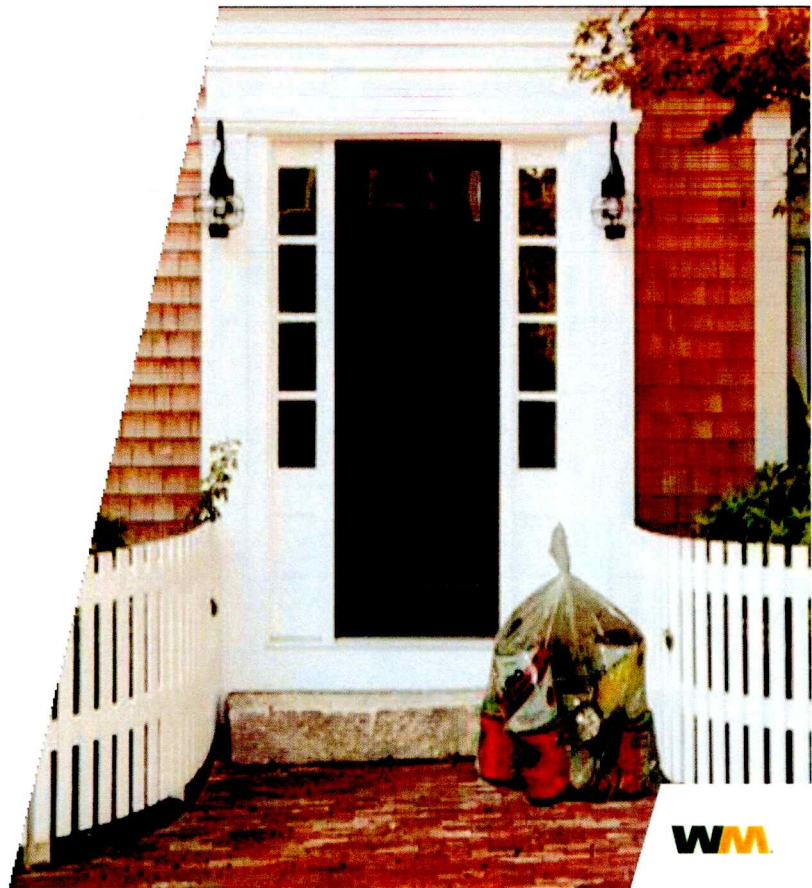

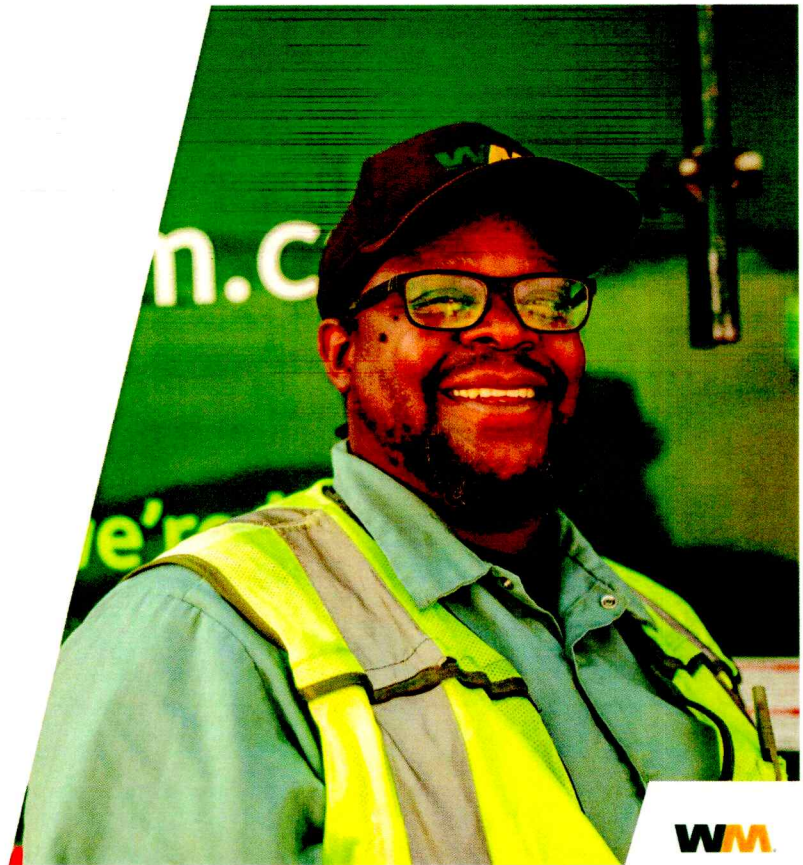
## Waste Management Green Facts
